II. **ABI Asset Sales Committee ListServ**

The Committee posts periodic and timely announcements on upcoming educational programs and topics of interest on our dedicated ListServ. Committee members receive ListServ posts via email. To ensure timely receipt of ListServ emails, ask your IT department to add ABI and ABI Listserv to your safe senders list.

Committee members may also post questions or comments relevant to the Asset Sales Committee ListServ via the Committee Webpage. ListServ posts may be used by Committee members to discuss recent opinions and pending legislation; ask questions about applicable procedure or precedent, such as locating professionals for a local assignment; and share insight on news related to asset sales in the trade press.

III. **Free Educational Programs**

Semi-Annual Programs. The Asset Sales Committee presents semi-annual educational programs on relevant topics and trends at ABI's Annual Spring Meeting and Winter Leadership Conference. Continued education credits are typically available for such program attendees. Conference materials are also available to Committee members.

Webinars. The Committee hosts two free Webinars each year on topics of interests relevant to asset sales in bankruptcy. Continued education credits may be available for a nominal administration fee.

Committee Conference Calls. The Committee also hosts two free conference calls each year for members to share legislative or other updates.
